#### ABSTRACT FOR PAPER AND POSTER PRESENTATION FOR TOXOCON – 15, MADURAI

The scientific committee invites abstract for paper and Poster presentations for TOXOCON-15, Madurai.

## ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The abstract must be structured, typed in English using MS- Word format with double spacing and Times New Roman(font size 12). Title should be in upper case (font size 14). Abstract should not exceed 400 words and must be followed by 3-5 key words. The name of authors and affiliations should follow immediately under the Title, highlighting the name of the presenting author. DO NOT include degrees or professional designation. Only one paper/Poster presentation per delegate is permitted. Final decision regarding the type of presentation (paper/poster) rests with the scientific committee. Details for paper/Poster presentation will be informed to participants along with acceptance letter.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION**

- Please read the instructions carefully before starting to submit your abstract. All abstracts must be submitted in English and must be submitted electronically. Therefore, no paper abstracts will be accepted. Abstracts not prepared correctly will not be considered for reviewing
- 1. LANGUAGE: Abstract must be typed and presented in English
- 2. WORD LIMIT: The abstract must be written within 500 words. Excluding title, and the names of the author (s) and their institutions
- 3. CONTENT: The submitted abstracts must contain the following:
- 4. Objectives: State the main objective of the study
- 5. Materials and methods: Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted
- 6. Results: Present the main results with appropriate statistics
- Conclusion: Limit the conclusions to those that are directly supported by the results.





## ABSTRACT

- TITLE: The title of the abstract must be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS with the exception of scientific names, which should be in upper and lower case forms and italicized.
- 9. PRESENTING AUTHOR DETAILS: The presenting author's name must be underlined and must be in CAPITALLETTERS
- 10. The presenting author's name, institution, address, telephone and email address must be provided. Presenting authors must be registered for the conference. Only Registered delegates will be allowed to present.

#### PAPER PRESENTATION CRITERIA

Presentation should be 7min duration only and to be in Microsoft Power Point format.

#### **POSTER PRESENTATION CRITERIA**

Project content has to be put on a vertical POSTER of size 48" (height) \* 36" (width). Height may be lower, but width should not exceed 36". Speakers will have 7 minutes duration to present their contents to the judges.

#### **RANKING CRITERIA**

There will be negative marking for crossing time limit and if any promotional / commercial content is present in any presentation.

Best paper/Poster in Faculty and PG category will be awarded separately. Please note that paper/poster presentation slots are limited due to Covid. First come first basis.
